





# The Holy Month of Ramadhan Is Approaching!

Allah says in the Qur'an: "O you who believe! Fasting is prescribed to you as it was prescribed to those before you, that you may (learn) self-restraint." (Al-Baqarah:183)

The holy month of Ramadhan is approaching soon. It is a blessed month. Muslims all over the world should welcome the arrival of Ramadhan with cheer and happiness for it carries blessings, forgiveness and mercy.

Fasting is observed for one month every year. During fasting, man abstains from food and water from sunrise to sunset in obedience to the command of Allah.

This act is performed in order to reduce man's materialism and increase his spirituality, so that he may be able to lead a truly spiritual life in this world. In the process, he spends more time in the worship of Allah.

Fasting awakens in man the feeling of gratefulness. The temporary deprivation of food and water stresses for him the importance of these things as divine blessings.

Then when he partakes of food and water after having experienced hunger and thirst, he can feel how truly precious is the food and water provided to him abundantly by Allah. This experience increases manifold his feelings of gratitude to Allah.

Fasting produces moral discipline within man. By restricting the basic things he desires, the devotee is trained to lead a life of self-restraint and not of permissiveness.

By having a curb put on his various desires for one month at a time man is trained to lead a life of self-restraint for the whole year, making no attempt to exceed the limits set by Allah.

What man does by fasting is engage himself more and more in the remembrance and worship of Allah, and in the recitation of the Qur'an. Thus fasting serves as a strategy to increase the efficacy of worship. In this way Allah accepts our worship in its heightened form.

Fasting is, in short, a training course. Its purpose is to place man on a special spiritual plane for one month so that he may be better able to lead the life of a true devotee of Allah and a true lover of humanity.

May Allah (S.W.T.) accept our fasting and all of our good deeds, amin.



# The Union Donates \$100,000 to Islamic College

Islam gave a very high priority to learning and education, this was stated by a High Court judge and the Chairman of the Islamic Union of Hong Kong, Mr. A.R Suffaid.

Mr. Suffaid was speaking at the graduation ceremony of the Islamic College in Chai Wan recently.

"In fact, learning knowledge and education became sure of the main reason for the Islamic Golden Age which ran from the 8th Century to 15th Century, a time when the Islamic World stretched from Mongolia to Spain." said Mr. Suffaid.

"During the period of the Islamic Golden Age", Mr Suffaid noted, "Islamic scholars and universities contributed greatly to arts, literature, philosophy, physics, astronomy, sciences and technology."

"Islam encourages thinkers of the day to seek out knowledge and as a result many famous and reputable universities were founded such as University of Al Karaouine in Morocco founded in 859 AD and also the Al Azhar University in Egypt founded in 975 AD." he said.

In the same ceremony, the Islamic Union of Hong Kong donated \$100,000 to the school management for their bus service for students living far apart. This is the second year the Islamic Union has made such a donation to the College.

Bro. O.M. Arab, Honorary Treasurer of the Islamic Union presented the cheque on behalf of the Union to the Principal of the College, Sister Zareenah Ho.

# Dr. Haji SA CHING HONG, YUSUF 1947-2014

Dr. Sa Ching Hong Yusuf or "Sa Yee Sang" as he was affectionately known, is no longer with us. He has returned to Allah (SWT).

On the morning of 4 April 2014 he passed away peacefully at Chengdu Hospital after a short illness. He was 67 years of age.

Born in Sichuan, China, Dr. Sa came to Hong Kong in 1975 and quickly established himself as an outstanding practitioner of Chinese medicine.

He traveled to many places treating many well known personalities and he spent several years in Vancouver, Canada where it was reported, those who wished to see him had to register two months in advance.

Deeply religious, he often performed his prayers in Masjid Ammar where after worshipping the Almighty he would adjourn to the Islamic Centre Canteen on the fifth floor for his meals.

Such was his popularity – and demand for his services – that very often he had to stop eating in order to administer to those who wished to consult him. Following such consultation – and writing prescriptions – he would

return to his meal only to find another brother or sister waiting to seek his services. Dr. Sa never complained and willingly – and freely – administered to his patients.

A regular and generous donor to charitable causes, he responded to the devastating May 2008 earthquake in Sichuan by raising funds and traveling to some of the areas affected, distributing aid to victims be they Muslims or non-Muslims. In particular, he was very much saddened by the damage and destruction to many Mosques in the area.

Even after his retirement about four years ago, he continued to provide his services free of charge, to those who wished to consult him.

At a religious function held on 12

April 2014 in the Seminar Room of Masjid Ammar and Osman Ramju Sadick Islamic Centre organized by the Hong Kong Muslim Women's Association, Hajia Jamilah Wong Heung Kwan spoke movingly of the contributions Dr. Sa made to the Muslim community not only in Hong Kong but also elsewhere.

"Dr. Sa served with strong Iman." she said. "Many members of our community regardless of their nationality at one time or another benefited from his expert knowledge of Chinese medicine. He never said no to anyone who needed his services. He even sacrificed his lunches and dinners in the canteen which he used as a "clinic", to serve our Muslim brothers and sisters." she continued.

Dr. Sa was buried on Saturday, 5 April 2014 at the Chengdu cemetery after janazah prayers at the Huang Cheng Mosque attended by several hundred Muslims.

The Muslim community has lost an outstanding practitioner of Chinese medicine. Many Muslims have lost a good friend. He will be sadly missed.

May Allah (SWT) grant him entry into Paradise.

# Muslims of Luyan

Once upon a time, not so long ago, the village of Luyan in Pangasinan province in the Philippines was a stronghold of non-Muslims. There wasn't a Muslim amongst the population of more than one thousand people.

This all started to change in 1993 when Alex Carlos was employed by a construction company in Bahrain. In his adopted home, Carlos came into contact with many Muslims, and this led him to attend classes on Islam and to start reading about the religion.

Two years after arriving in Bahrain, Carlos embraced Islam taking the Muslim name of Ahmed.

Bro. Ahmed returned to Luyan in 1997. Together with his wife Fatimah, also a convert, they began actively to spread the teachings of Islam among the population most of whom are farmers. Because of their activities and the enthusiasm with which they carried out their work, the couple was shunned by non-Muslims and their efforts to build a mosque met with strong resistance.

Nevertheless they persisted. With a generous donation of 500,000 pesos (about HK\$100,000) from one brother in Bahrain, and after convincing the authorities, the first Mosque in Luyan was built three years ago. To-day, there are over 300 Muslims in Luyan – all converts to Islam.

After bringing non-Muslims to Islam, Bro. Ahmed started follow up work to keep in touch with them and organised regular classes on Islam not only for Muslims but also for non-Muslims including some police officers. Literatures on the religion are also distributed when available and gatherings for converts organised.

The Mosque has become the most important place for the Muslims to congregate. An average of 20 worshippers attend daily prayers while Jumah prayers attract a far larger congregation of about 90. Many however could not participate because of a shortage of space.


With financial support from the Union, summer classes are held for adults and youths. At these classes

students are taught how to perform ablution, how to pray and other aspects of Islam. The opportunity is also taken to teach the boys and girls subjects taught in their schools.

The Holy Month of Ramadhan is a happy month for the Muslims of Luyan as it enables them to break fast, perform Magrib and share a simple meal together. Needless to say celebration of the two Eid festivals is particularly joyous.

Bro. Mohammed Islam a convert from Manila, was in Hong Kong recently to perform street da'wah at the invitation of Discover Islam, Bahrain and the Da'wah Committee of the Union. Bro. Mohammed has advised that as da'wah work is intensifying, funds are needed to purchase a second hand vehicle so as to access remote areas and transport mayats for burial at a Muslim cemetery which is very far away.

At the moment, travel to remote areas for da'wah is by a motorcycle with a side car which often broke down.

A group of officials from the Indonesian Ministry of Religious Affairs and Bank Negara Indonesia (BNI) recently made a courtesy call on the Union.



# Mosque Tour & Street Da'wah in Hong Kong

**Bro. Mohammad Islam**, a Filipino from Manila, the Philippines, is based in Bahrain and working with "Discover Islam". During his two-day stay in Hong Kong, he was assisted and supported by a local Filipino Muslim groups, HIG-Helper's Islam Group, in the Street Da'wah propagation. Bro. Islam was invited to Hong Kong by The Islamic Union of Hong Kong, and sponsored by Discover Islam, Bahrain.

#### **Shelly Street Mosque Tours**

The Shelly Street Mosque (Jamia Masjid) tour is an indirect conveyance of the teaching of Islam to non-Muslims. It is an effective way of clearing away people's misconceptions brought about by wrong information being fed in the media. During my two-day visit to the Mosque between 2 May and 3 May, 2014; I got an opportunity to meet people of different nationalities i.e. Japanese, British, American, South African,

Korean, Spanish and Chinese, visiting the masjid for the first time in their life and they got a chance to see the structure being the oldest of its kind in Hong Kong, and how to perform prayers, performance of wudu, the direction of prayers. They heard the recitation of the Opening chapter of the Quran (Sura Al-Fatiha) and its meaning in English, the recitation of the Adhan with its English translation. The Quran and the scien-

tific aspects of the Quran; where they were surprised to know, that it contains information about the universe, embryology, water cycle and others.

It's a very fulfilling task and should be continued with the training and empowerment of people who have a passion to do da'wah fi' sabilillah by implementing the tour guiding principles of ATMT (Awareness Through Mosque Tour).

#### **Status Square (Charter Garden Road)**

In my recent visit to this place (1 & 4 May, 2014) which is bustling with expatriates community mainly Filipinos working in Hong Kong. I got a chance to conduct table da'wah, as well as, street da'wah with special participation and assistance from the very energetic and enthusiastic Filipino volunteers, mostly newly revert Muslim ladies, of the Union. Alhamdulillah! There were seven people declared their faith in the Oneness of GOD. We distributed books and most of the sisters went to

the extent wherein they roamed around the vicinity to distribute pamphlets and were able to consume the stock allocated for distribution. The experience is an eye opener for those passionate volunteers of the Islamic Union regarding the importance of street da'wah. It is essential that they go out in the street during the weekend and spend at least one hour for them to get used to the environment and the rigors that it entails, as well as , enhancing their capability to convey the message of Islam to the non-

Muslims Filipinos who are just wasting their spare time. This will give the volunteers an impetus and enough exposure that they needed to face the vicissitudes of da'wah fi'sabilillah as exemplified by our last Prophet (peace be upon him). For its part, "Discover Islam" will be able to assist in the training and empowerment of the volunteers plus the dispatch of books to augment their da'wah activities.

# Don't be angry

Abu Hurayrah (RA) reported, "A man said to the Prophet (SAW), 'Advise me.' The Prophet (SAW) said, 'Do not get angry.' The man asked again, and the Prophet (SAW) said, 'Do not get angry." (Imam Bukhari)

The above hadith tells us that a man who asked the Prophet (SAW) to advise with all-comprehensive saying so that he might remember it. The Prophet Muhammad (SAW) advised him not to get angry. The man asked again and again and the Prophet (SAW) repeated his same reply. This indicates that anger is the root of all evil and that avoiding it is the key to all goodness.

When the companion heard this hadith from the Prophet (SAW), he said, "I reconsidered what the Prophet (SAW) said and I reached the conclusion that anger is the root of all evil."

(Imam Ahmad)

The hadith indicates two things:

First: The Prophet (SAW) commanded the companion to adhere to good morals and manner, such as generosity, forbearance, modesty, humbleness, bearing hardabstention from ships. harming others, forgiveness, suppression of one's anger, and decency. If a person adheres to these and becomes manners habituated to them, he will avoid anger even if there are channels leading to it.

Second: the Prophet (SAW) may mean that a person should not act in response to angry irritations. One should try hard to abandon any actions when he is in angry state. Once dominating man, anger will control him.

If a man does not act according to his angry state and does his best to control it, the evil arising from such anger will be driven away. His anger may be appeased, as if he had not gotten angry at all as Allah (SWT) said: "And when they are angry, forgive" (Ash-Shura:37). Allah (SWT) also said:" Who represses anger, and who pardon men; verily, Allah loves the doers." good (Ali Imran:134).

The Prophet (SAW) used to command the angry person to stick to a behaviour that will divert his anger. The Prophet (SAW) also commended the person who controls himself when he is angry. On the authority of Sulaiman bin Surad who said," When I was sitting in the company of the Prophet (SAW), two men abused each other and the face of one became red with anger, and his jugular vein swelled." On that the Prophet (SAW) said:" I know a word, the saying of which will cause him to relax, if he will say it. If he savs:" A'udhu billahi minash-shaitanir-rajim" which means 'I seek refuge with Allah from Satan,' then all anger will go away."

Abu Dzarr who reported that the Prophet (SAW) said: "When anyone of you gets angry while he is standing, he should sit down. If his anger is not repressed, he should lie down." (abu Dawud).

The hadith indicates that the person who is standing is ready to take revenge, while the person who is sitting down is less liable to such behaviour. When he lies down, he is further away from such behaviour. Thus, the Prophet (SAW) commanded us to keep away from the behaviour of

taking revenge.

Ibnu Abbas recorded that the Prophet (SAW) said: "When anyone of you is angry, he should keep silent. The Prophet (SAW) said it thrice." (Imam Ahmad). This hadith gives a great cure for anger as an angry person almost always utters words that he regrets after his anger is appeased. He may insult people or cause harm to them. If he keeps silent, all such harmful words will not be said.

A man talk to Urwah bin Muhammad As-Sa'dy which led to being angry. Urwah stood up, performed ablution and said: "My father told me on the authority of my grandfather 'Atiyyah that the Prophet (SAW) said:" Anger is caused by Satan. Satan is created from fire. Fire is extinguished by When anyone gets angry, he should perform ablution." (Abu Daud). The Prophet (SAW) said further: " The strong (man) is not the one who overcomes people by strength, but the strong is the one who controls himself while in anger." (Bukhari).

# The Palestinian Tragedy: The Never-Ending Story

It is lamentable that regardless of how loud the Palestinians cry for help against the injustice and oppression inflicted upon them, few people in the world support their legitimate rights: return of the Palestinian refugees and establishing their state on their historical land.

On 15th May 2014, the Palestinians commemorated the 66th anniversary of Al-Nakbah (The Catastrophe of Losing Palestine). On the same day in 1948, Jewish European immigrants declared their state on the land of Palestine. The Jewish immigrants, with the support of Britain and then the United States, occupied the whole land of Palestine causing the continuous suffering and agony of the Palestinian people.

Because of the Israeli occupation of Palestine, wars and violence ripped the Middle East for many decades. Most people are not aware of the reasons behind the ongoing fighting between Israelis and Palestinians in the Land of Peace: Palestine. The following is a summary of the main stages of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict during the last hundred years.

In last decades of 19th century, the Zionist movement was very active in Europe. The Zionists called for establishing a national home for the Jews in Palestine depending on vague historical claims. Logically, Jews had no right to claim to Palestine merely

because they ruled that land two thousand years ago.

Palestine was part of the Ottoman Empire until World War I. Palestine at that time had a large Muslim majority, a Christian minority and a Jewish minority. For many centuries, the Palestinians of different religions lived together in harmony with no history of animosity among them.

During World War I, the Zionist movement was strong enough to influence the British Empire to support their demand of establishing a national home for the Jews in Palestine. In

February 1917, Arthur Balfour, British Foreign Secretary, promised Lord Rothschild, head of the British Zionist movement, to establish a national home for the Jews in Palestine.

Britain does not hold any right to issue such a promise since it does not own Palestine. Undoubtedly, Palestine belongs to the Palestinians of different religions living on that land for hundreds of years. Moreover, the Jewish Zionists were citizens of European countries and therefore had no legal right to obtain a national home or establish a state in Palestine. Naturally, the Palestinians rejected such an unjust and unreasonable British prom-

After the defeat of the Ottomans in World War I, The League of Nations put Palestine under the Mandate of the British Empire. Under British influence, the Mandate included an item about facilitating immigration of Jews to Palestine. The Mandate emphasized that there should be no prejudice to the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine.

In 1922 the British undertook the first census of Palestine after being granted the Mandate over Palestine. The total number of the population in Palestine was 752,048, comprising 589,177 Muslims, 83,790 Jews, 71,464 Christians and 7,617 persons belonging to other religious groups.

Against the will of the Palestinians, Britain allowed hundreds of thousands of Jewish immigrants from Europe to settle down in Palestine from 1920 to 1947. It was apparent that the British authorities in Palestine favoured the demands of the Jewish immigrants against the essential rights of the local Palestinians. This led to many revolts by the Palestinians against the British and the Jewish immigrants during the Mandate period.

In 1939, the British revision of the immigration policies which proposed limiting the number of Jewish immigrants to Palestine turned the Zionists against the British authorities. The Jewish immigrants formed terrorist groups that launched horrific acts of terror against the Palestinians and British troops during the last few years of the British Mandate over Palestine.

In 1945, a demographic study showed that the population of Palestine had grown to 1,764,520, comprising 1,061,270 Muslims, 553,600 Jews, 135,550 Christians and 14,100 people

of other religious groups. Due to the increase of the number of Jewish clashes immigrants, frequently between the Palestinians and the Jewish immigrants. Thus the British authorities faced a difficult situation in Palestine.

In 1947, Britain decided to pass the issue to the United Nations, which under immense American pressure, adopted Resolution 181 dividing Palestine into two states; giving the Jewish immigrants 56% of Palestine and only 44% to the Palestinians who are the indigenous people of Pales-

The UN Resolution 181 was invalid as it is against the basic principles for which the world organization was established upon, namely, to uphold the people's right to selfdetermination. By denying the Palestinians, who formed the majority of population in Palestine, the right to decide for themselves, the United Nations had violated its own charter. Therefore, the legitimacy of Israel is questionable because it depends mainly on such an illegal resolution. Moreover, the UN Resolution 181 was issued due to American intimidation of newly-established UN member-countries in Latin America. It is worth mentioning that the UN Resolution 181 was voted down by all UN member-countries in the Middle East. Therefore, Israel is like a strange organ that is transplanted in the body of the Middle East.

Although the Palestinians rejected such an invalid and unjust resolution, the Jewish immigrants declared their state on 14th May 1948. Consequently, the Jewish terrorist groups, such as Irgun, Haganah and Lehi had a free hand to continue their campaign of terror against the Palestinians. Moreover, the British authorities extended their help once again and handed over government buildings, train stations and military camps to the Jewish Agency before withdrawing the British troops from Palestine.

Aiming at protecting the Palestinians and the integrity of their land, the neighbouring Arab countries declared war against Israel. However, the Arab armies were less in number and weapons than that of the Israeli army which received full support from the USA and some European countries. The United Nations negotiated a truce between warring parties in Palestine in 1949. Nevertheless, the Israelis violated the truce and gradually seized 22% of the land of Palestine in addition to what was allocated to them according to UN Resolution 181.

According to the United Nations Resolution 181, Israel should protect the interests of the large Palestinian population in the lands allocated to the Jewish state. On the contrary, the Israeli army, composed of Jewish terrorist groups, launched an organized campaign of terror against the Palestinians to force them out of these

Such campaign of Israeli terror resulted in the killing of hundreds of Palestinians and forcing around 800,000 out of their own lands. Refugee camps were established in neighbouring Arab countries for those refugees and hundreds of thousands of Palestinians are still living in these refugee camps until today.

In 1967, Israel launched an attack against neighbouring Arab countries. The Israeli army occupied the Gaza Strip, the West Bank and East Jerusalem. The Security Council issued its Resolution 242 calling upon Israel to withdraw from the lands it occupied during that aggression. Israel challenged the United Nations and did not apply the Resolution 242.

As the USA has given full military

support to Israel, the Arab countries were unable to win a decisive military victory against the newly-established state. Accordingly, the Palestinians realized that they themselves should lead the struggle against the Israeli occupation.

In 1987, the Palestinian youth had launched the First Uprising against the Israeli occupation. The Palestinian youth threw stones at the Israeli soldiers who responded with live ammunitions and in many cases broke the arms of Palestinian young people who were captured by Israeli soldiers. Due to Israel's strong support from the USA, the United Nations was unable to stop the Israeli atrocities against the Palestinian civilians.

In 1991, a peace conference, cosponsored by the United States and the Soviet Union, was held in Madrid. The Palestinians agreed to accept the existence of Israel in the biggest part of their land in exchange for ending the Israeli occupation of the Gaza Strip, the West Bank and East Jerusalem.

Unfortunately, each new Israeli government rejected what the previous government agreed upon with the Palestinians. The negotiations between the two sides continued for almost ten years but ended in failure. That was mainly due to Israel's insistence that it will not end its occupation of East Jerusalem and will continue building new settlements in the Palestinian lands.

The Palestinians who suffered daily under Israeli occupation realized that there was no hope of gaining their freedom and establishing their state even on a small part of their land. Moreover, life under Israeli occupation became increasingly impossible. Israeli forces regularly confiscated private lands, imprisoned individuals without trial, demolished family

homes, bulldozed orchards and crops, destroyed shops and businesses, placed entire towns under curfew and shot and killed Palestinian civilians indiscriminately.

During more than six decades of Israeli occupation, the Palestinians were deprived of any military power to defend themselves against the Israeli aggressions. On the other hand, the Israelis with full support from the USA, was able to build one of the strongest armies in the region. The majority of young Palestinians, out of hopelessness, frustration and daily humiliation under the Israeli occupation, had decided to resist the Israeli occupation by all means. Under these circumstances, the Second Uprising erupted in the year 2000.

The Second Uprising witnessed many suicide bombers who blew them-

selves up among civilians inside Israel. While these acts are condemned, there is a need to condemn the main reason behind such actions and put an end to it: the Israeli occupation of the land of Palestine. The suicide bombers were victims of the Israeli occupation which humiliates the Palestinians daily, destroy their morale and practice the worst types of apartheid against them.

The Western Media often shows the destructions that a suicide bomber inflects on the Israelis, but it rarely shows the destruction caused by Israeli attacks against the Palestinians. A comparison between the victims on both sides will show the Israeli excessive use of force against the Palestinians. According to statistics from B'Tselem, The Israeli Center for Human Rights in the Occupied Territories, 1,097 Israelis and at least 6,638 Palestinians have been killed. On another hand, According to statistics from The United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs, 9,226 Israelis and 49,518 Palestinians have been injured from September 2000 till August 2012. It is an irony that Israel is still claiming that it is in a state of self-defense against the Palestinians.

However, there was a glimpse of hope for achieving peace between Israelis and Palestinians. The Arab countries declared the Arab initiative of peace in 2004. They offered peace and normalization of relations with Israel in return for the lands that it occupied in 1967: Golan Heights in Syria; East Jerusalem, West Bank and Gaza Strip in Palestine. According to that initiative, the Palestinians could establish their state on just 22% of the historical land of Palestine. Unfortunately, even with these huge concessions, this initiative fell on deaf ears in Israel.

The suffering of Palestinians has been continuing for 66 years. Peace negotiations failed because of Israel's unwillingness to return even a small part of Palestine to the Palestinians to establish their independent state. While the borders of the Jewish state are the ones which appeared on the UN Partition Plan of Palestine issued in 1947, the Israelis did not declare the borders of their State until today. This shows their clear intention to usurp more Palestinian lands.

In spite of Israel's violations of

Palestinian human rights and its defiance of the United Nations resolutions, the USA continued its unflagging support of Israel. The bias of the USA towards Israel has been apparent in the UN Security Council when American veto blocked all the resolutions that condemned the Israeli crimes against the Palestinians.

The American and Israeli media succeeded in labeling the Palestinians resisting the Israeli occupation as "terrorists". This is ironic considering the fact that it is legal for all peoples to resist any occupation of their countries. It is lamentable that regardless of how loud the Palestinians cry for help against the injustice and oppression inflicted upon them, few people in the world support their legitimate rights: return of the Palestinian refugees and establishing their state on their historical land.

# New York Police Muslim Tracking Unit Disbanded

A special New York Police Department unit that sparked controversy by tracking the daily lives of Muslims in an effort to detect terror threats has been disbanded, said a police spokesman.

The Demographics Unit, conceived with the help of a CIA agent working with the NYPD, assembled databases on where Muslims lived, shopped, worked and prayed. Plainclothes officers infiltrated Muslim student groups, put informants in mosques, monitored sermons and cataloged Muslims who adopted Americanized surnames.

New York Civil Liberties Union Executive Director Donna Lieberman hailed the decision, saying police-community relations took a blow from the unit's broad surveillance of all Muslims, not just people suspected of wrongdoing.

"We hope this means an end to the dragnet approach to policing that has been so harmful to police-community relations and a commitment to going after criminal suspicion, rather than innocent New Yorkers," said Lieberman, whose organization is involved in lawsuits over the practice.

# Islamic Leader Join Fight Against Extremism

China's top Islamic leaders urged the nation's Muslims to resist religious extremisn and fight terrorism after a number of violent attacks in the Xinjiang Uygur autonomous region in March and April.

Around 80 religious leaders and scholars discussed Islamic doctrine by quoting the Quran and the teachings of the Prophet Muhammad on 14 & 15 May in Urumqi, the region's capital. On 13 May, Islamic leaders in China passed a proposal calling on

all Muslims in the country to regulate their behavior, resist religious extremism and improve their moral outlook.

Abulitif Abdureyim, director of the Xinjiang Islamic Association, said governments at all levels in the region are battling religious extremism.

"The attackers who carried out the terrorist activities cannot go to heaven because they have violated the sayings in the Qur'an." he said.

The Sultan of Brunei has announced that 1 May would commence a gradual implementation of Sharia law in the country.

About 70 percent of Brunei's population of 400,000 people are Muslim.

By introducing Sharia law in phases, some of the worst forms of punishment will not be enforced from the start.

According to the Brunei Times carried a story on Wednesday that said: "The first phase of the Order covers general offences set by the state, including disrespecting the month of Ramadan and not performing Friday prayers. The general offences are punishable by fines, imprisonment or both."

# 魯岩的穆斯林

不久之前, 菲律賓Pangasinan 省 的魯岩還是個非穆斯林聚居的小村 莊。村內約一千的人口中曾經一度 無人信奉伊斯蘭。

這一切直到1993年開始有了改變 。村內一名建築工人Alex Carlos受 一間建築公司聘請派駐巴林。 Carlos在當地穆斯林的薰陶下開始 接觸伊斯蘭, 也因此參加了有關伊 斯蘭的課程, 並閱讀相關書籍。

兩年後, Carlos在巴林正式皈信伊 斯蘭, 取經名Ahmed。

1997年, Ahmed兄弟攜同他的妻 子Fatimah (同為入教者) 回到魯岩 , 開始活躍地在村內傳播伊斯蘭信 仰。面對他們在宣教事務上的積極 與熱忱, 不少當地的非穆斯林表現 抗拒,令他們在當地修建清真寺的 工作遇到不少阻力。

幾經波折, 他們的堅持獲得了回

報。一名巴林兄弟慷慨地捐出 \$500,000披索 (港幣\$100,000), 在 說服當局之後, 首座清真寺得以在 三年前建成。如今,魯岩 穆斯林人 口超過三百, 全為入教人士。

然而,宣教工作不能只是引領非 穆斯林入教,跟進工作亦是一項挑 戰。如何繼續與他們接觸, 向他們 傳授伊斯蘭知識及鞏固他們的信仰 同樣重要。因此,清真寺除了為穆 斯林,也為非穆斯林(當中也包括一 些員警) 恆常地開辦伊斯蘭課程,並 透過組織團體活動, 向入教者派發 有關伊斯蘭的宗教書籍。

清真寺成為魯岩穆斯林禮拜的重 要場所。每日平均有20人進入清真 寺做禮拜,逢主麻日更有90多人參 加聚禮; 由於清真寺地方不足, 不 能容納所有穆斯林入寺禮拜。

清真寺獲伊聯會資助,為當地青 年及成年人舉辦暑期課程。課程主

要教授如何洗小淨, 拜功等各方面 的伊斯蘭知識, 另外, 亦借此機會 為寺內兒童開辦課程。

齌月對魯岩的穆斯林來說是既神 聖又快樂的月份。他們在寺內開齋 、進行昏禮及一同享用簡單的餐點 。除了齋月外, 開齋節和忠孝節亦 為當地穆斯林帶來無窮喜樂。

近日,應巴林「發現伊斯蘭」組 織與伊聯會的宣教委員會之邀,來 自馬尼拉的Mohammed Islam兄弟來 港進行街頭宣教活動(他本身亦是一 名入教者)。Mohammed 兄弟表示宣 教工作在不斷加強, 魯岩 清真寺 急需購買一部二手車以便去偏遠的 地區進行宣教, 及將歸真穆斯林的 遺體運往遙遠的穆斯林墳場。

# 懷念沙正康醫生(1947-2014)



沙醫生與教胞分享保健知識

大家都暱稱他為"沙醫生"的 沙正康醫生已離開了我們,順命 歸真。

沙醫生因病入住成都醫院,在 2014年4月4日上午安祥離世,享 年67歳。

沙正康醫出生於四川,1975年 來港定居後旋即躋身業界翹楚。

沙醫生遍遊各地,為不少知名 人士診症。他曾經在加拿大溫哥 華從業數年,經報導後門庭若市 ,慕名求診者需於兩個月前預約 才能就醫。

沙醫生是位虔誠的穆斯林,經常到愛群清真寺做禮拜;向全能真主祈禱後,他會前往五樓餐廳用膳。在這短短的用餐期間,不少教胞已聞風而至,向他諮詢病況。沙醫生會耐心地向病患診症開方,從不怠慢;即使犧牲了用膳時間,亦無半句怨言。

沙醫生宅心仁厚,樂善好施。 2008年5月四川大地震後,他迅速 為當地災民籌募善款,並親身前 往災區,將捐款送到受災人士手 中;不論是穆斯林或非穆斯林, 沙醫生都一視同仁。探訪中,他 對清真寺在地震中損毀尤感痛心 四年前沙正康醫生正式退休, 他仍繼續為前來的病患義診,不 收分文,來者不拒。

2014年4月12日,香港回教婦女會假愛群清真寺暨林士德伊斯蘭中心六樓研討室,為沙醫生舉行宗教活動。活動中,主席哈佳王香君為沙正康醫生對香港及至海外穆斯林社群的貢獻深表敬意。

"沙醫生帶著深厚的信仰服務 社群。"她說。 "我們當中不少 人,不分國籍,都曾經受惠於沙 醫生的精湛醫術。他從不向求診 者說不。他甚至犧牲自己的午膳 及晚飯時間為弟兄姊妹義診,餐 廳對他來說,儼然是另一間診所 。"

沙正康醫生於2014年4月5日(星期六)在成都墳場安葬。在此以前,數百名穆斯林出席了皇城清真寺為沙醫生舉行的殯禮祈禱。

# 尋貴夜功課多辦

萊麥丹齋月是一個非常尊貴 和吉慶的月份,它是一年之中最 尊贵的月份,尊貴的《古蘭經》 就是在這個月份降示的。真主說 : "萊麥丹(月)中,開始降示 《古蘭經》, 引導世人, 昭示明 證,以便遵循正道,分別真偽, 故在此月中,你們應當齋戒。" (《古蘭經》2:185) 真主在《 古蘭經》97 章中更明確了降示 《古蘭經》是在萊麥丹月中的尊 貴之夜。

真主說: "我在那高貴的夜 間確已降示它(《古蘭經》), 你怎能知道那高貴的夜間是什麽 ? 那高貴的夜間勝過一千個月, 衆天使和嚕哈(哲布萊大天使) 奉他們的主的命令,爲一切事務 而在那夜間降臨, 那夜間全是平 安的,直到黎明顯著的時候。" (《古蘭經》97:1-5)

真主在蓋德爾夜(高貴的夜 ) 將《古蘭經》從被保護的天牌 上一次降至接近大地的一層天, 然後,在二十三年間零星地由哲 布萊大天使奉真主的命令傳達給 穆聖 (願主賜他平安與吉慶)。 這一夜非常之高貴,它優越於一 千個月, 是一年之中最高贵的夜 晚,也就是說,在此一夜之間所 做的善功, 勝過一千個月的善功 。但這絕不是說,做了這一夜的 善功,就可以一千個月不做了。 經典的明文是闡明這一夜的高貴 。那麽,這高貴之夜是在哪一夜 呢?《古蘭經》中未有提及,聖 訓中雖有提及,但沒有確認是哪 一夜, 仍需要尋找, 據聖妻阿依 莎的傳述: 穆聖(願主賜他平安 與吉慶)說: "你們當在萊麥丹 月的最後十天內的單數日子裏尋 找蓋德爾夜(貴夜)。"

蓋德爾夜究竟是哪一夜晚, 衆學者意見不一, 有的認爲是齋 月的第二十一夜晚,有的認爲是 第二十三夜晚,有的認爲是第二 十五夜晚,有的認爲是第二十九 夜晚; 但多數學者則認爲是在第 二十七夜晚。據伊本•奧默爾的 傳述,穆聖(願主賜他平安與吉 慶)說: "誰尋找蓋德爾夜,就 讓他在第二十七夜晚尋找它吧!

没有明确盖德尔夜的哲理, 就是让我们在齋月的最後十天, 把握机会,大家應增加功修。效 仿穆聖(願主賜他平安與吉慶)的 做法, 據阿卜杜拉・本・奧默爾

的傳述: "真主的使者在齋月的 後十天'依阿提卡夫'(坐靜-举意为接近真主,在清真寺内静 修,不出寺门)。"另據聖妻阿 依莎傳述: "穆聖在進入後十天 的時候,他便勒緊腰帶,通宵禮 拜, 並叫醒家人(多做禮拜)。 "因为没有任何一个人知道明年 的莱麦丹斋月是否还健在。

在蓋德爾夜(貴夜)的功課 ,除當日的主命宵禮外,沒有其 他主命的拜功, 可以禮副功拜, 也可以恭誦古蘭經, 也可唸讃詞 紀念真主等。至於禮副功拜,禮 多少拜?有的說:最少禮兩拜, 最多無限制, 你可以禮一百拜, 兩百拜,礼的越多越好。

据圣妻阿依莎(求主喜悦她) 传述,她向真主的使者请教:真主 的使者啊!如果我知道哪一夜是 盖德尔夜,我应该怎么样做都阿( 祈求)?真主的使者答道:妳向真 主祈求:真主啊!你是宽恕的主, 你喜欢宽恕,你宽恕我吧!'"

穆圣说:"谁虔诚敬意希望 得到真主的回赐,在盖德尔夜通 宵达旦崇拜真主,真主将饶恕他 之前的讨错。"



一年一度的齊月即將來臨 , 穆斯林兄弟姊妹的心情無不 激動,個個翹首以盼。這是一 個偉大的月份,真主在此月降 示了《古蘭經》, 引導世人, 這個月份充滿了吉慶和恩慈。

齋月是伊斯蘭教曆中的第 九個月份——萊麥丹月。真主 為我們規定了每年在這個月份 齋戒。真主說: "信道的人們 啊! 齋戒已成為你們的定制, 猶如它曾為前人的定制一樣, 以便你們敬畏。"(《古蘭經 》2:183)

所謂齋戒,就是指從黎明 至日落,禁止吃、飲及房事。 並應戒除一起邪惡雜念,遠離 非法之舉,虔誠為真主而齋戒 如有人罵你,你應當對他說: "我是封齋之人。"

真主為我們規定了齋戒, 它成爲了伊斯蘭五大支柱之一 , 必定有其深奥的哲理。穆斯 林遵奉主命而齋戒, 是不容推 卸的責任。由於我們知識的缺 乏和有限, 故無法領略其奧義 之全貌。不過隨著時光的推移 和科學知識的發展, 我們對齋

# 繳納開齋捐 圓滿齋戒功

開齋捐,在香港也叫麥米錢, 為什麼叫麥米錢?香港的教胞把 Zakatul Fitri叫做麥米錢,是因 為繳納Zakatul Fitri,應該是繳 納食物:大麥、小麥、椰棗、 葡乾、大米等可以吃的食物。大 伊瑪目艾布哈尼法允許繳納食物 的價值(貨幣)。也許這就是把 Zakatul Fitri叫做麥米錢的原由 吧!在中國內地,有的地區也叫 費台爾錢。Zakatul Fitri直譯為 開齋捐或開齋的天課。

 ,是為了純潔封齋的人在齋戒其間言語及行為中的過錯,同時也是為了窮人有飯吃。誰在禮拜(開齋節會禮)之前繳納了開齋捐,那便是被接受的天課;誰在禮拜(會禮)之後繳納了它,它便是屬於一般的施捨。"

繳納開齋捐可以提前,提前多 少天?各教法學家在這一問題上 有著不同的主張。但不可延遲至 會禮之後, 正如前文所述。

開齋捐應該施散予哪些人?這 與主命的天課所施的物件是一樣 的,即《古蘭經》第九章六十節 所闡明的八種情況: "賑款只歸 於貧窮者、赤貧者、管理帳務 、心被團結者、無力贖身者、 能還債者、為主道工作者、。 第困者;這是真主的定制。"(《古 蘭經》9:60)

據聖訓的明文,開齋捐最應該施予的對象是窮人。因為穆聖(願真主賜他平安與吉慶)說: "在此一日(節日)你們應使他們(窮人)富足。"也就是說,讓窮人們也能愉快的歡度節日。

至於本年度的開齋捐,香港地區約折合為港幣三十元正,希望 教胞們按時繳納,以求得到真主 的承領,圓滿齋戒功修。

戒的裨益才有了一點認識,現簡述幾點與大家一道分享:

第二: 齋戒可增強意

志與耐力,從黎明至日落 ,這樣長的一段時間內 ,這樣長的一段制態望, 不吃、不飲、面前縱有佳美 的飲料和誘人的飯菜, 的飲料和誘人但也絕來 動絲毫。封齋之人敬 動絲毫。封齊之人敬 難強 主,自願遵守來到加強嗎 ?

第三,滌除私慾,闡 發憐憫之心。齋戒使人體 驗飢渴的痛苦,整天飽食 、飽飲,感受不到真主的 恩典。一旦失去方感真主 的恩典之宏大。飢渴使我 們體會到挨餓的滋味,藉 此可激發憐憫,仁愛的心 。穆聖說:"你們對世人 行善吧!真主會恩賜你們 。"

第四: 齋戒對健康有益。齋戒有益於健康已被現代醫學所證明。目前許多國家都採用飢餓療法(也就是齋戒)治療某些疾病。曾有一家雜誌登載:有三百例患糖尿病者,接

受飢餓療法後,治好了糖 尿病。真主的使者在一千 四百多年之前早已說過: "齋戒吧!你們健康快樂

值此尊貴齋月到來之際, 祈求真主賜大家身體健康, 高高興興地迎接萊麥丹月。
