

# **Eid Prayers** at Macau Masjid

Eid was observed in Macau on 6th July and as usual preparations were made for Eid Prayers to be held in the open grounds surrounding the very small and spartan Mosque that only accommodates about fifty worshippers at a time.

Unfortunately, the weather became very unsettled with heavy rain. This caused water clogging of all the open grounds on which plastic sheets had been placed for the congregation to perform prayers consequently the prayers had to be moved back to the Mosque and an extension behind the Mosque.

A total of four sessions of Eid Prayers were held with still some of the congregation having to perform their prayers in the open holding umbrellas on one hand to avoid being completely drenched but still leaving out some who were unable to perform their prayers since there were no qualified religious leaders to lead further prayer sessions.

This brings out the acute necessity for a new and larger Mosque to be built as soon as possible and it is ernestly hoped that the Macau government will see this pressing need and sanction the plans for the new Mosque and Islamic Centre Project to proceed without further delay.

The Islamic Union organized a Eid-ul-Fitr dinner on the 5/F floor Islamic Canteen attended by nearly 200 people.



Twenty participants from South Korea, Taiwan, Hong Kong, the Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, Myanmar, Cambodia, Singapore, Indonesia and Malaysia attended the International Muslimah Empowerment workshop.

The event, organised by the Regional Islamic Da'wah Council of Southeast Asia and the Pacific (RISEAP) in collaboration with the Islamic Information Centre (IIC), aimed to expose participants to the cultures and traditions of Sarawak.

During their brief stay, the women had the opportunity to visit the Sarawak Cultural Village and attend the Baitulmal Hari Raya Eid-ul-Fitr open house.

They also paid a courtesy call on Sarawak Islamic Council president Datu Misnu Taha and Head of State, Tun Pehin Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud, who is (RISEAP) president, to visit The Astana, the Governor House.

The group also visited St Joseph's Cathedral and the Sri Maha Mariamman (Hindu) Temple, which was the first time some of the participants had entered other houses of worship.

Although Islam is the official religion of Malaysia, Sarawak has no official state religion. It is the only state in Malaysia where Christians outnumber Muslims. Despite its racial and religious diversity, Sarawak is the most peaceful and harmonious state in the country. The Workshop provided an opportunity for the participants to learn how to promote multi-religious harmony and a better understanding Islam and other faiths.

A 30 members delegation from Hong Kong various Muslim organizations assembled at the Hung Hom station on 30 July early morning for the "2016 Guangzhou-Hong Kong Islamic Family Reunion Symposium" in Guangzhou. The delegation consisted of the Chairman of the Islamic Union of Hong Kong, Bro. A. R. Suffiad; Chairman of the Chinese Muslim Cultural & Fraternal Association, Haji Sat Chi Sang; Chairman of Hong Kong Chinese Muslim Association, Haji Yakoob Tsui Kam Fai; Chairlady of Hong Kong Muslim Women Association, Hajiah Jamilah Wong; Haji Saeed Uddin from The Incorporated Trustees of the Islamic Community Fund of Hong Kong, and the Chairman of the Hong Kong Islamic Youth Association, Bro. M. Ali Zaiq.

Upon arrival the delegation had lunch at the famous Hui Min Restaurant and continued to visit Guangzhou Xinshi Hui People Public Cemetery and offered dua for all the ancestors. In the evening the delegation attended a welcoming dinner held at Asia International Hotel's halal restaurant jointly hosted by the Department of Ethnic and Religious Affairs and the Guangzhou Islamic Association. Mr. Wang Mao Zhu, Secretary of Department of Ethnic and Religious Affairs gave a welcoming speech.

The following morning, after visiting the Saad bin

Ali Waqqas Mosque and graveyard, the delegation attended the "Guangzhou-Hong Kong Islamic Family Reunion Symposium". The Symposium was chaired by Mr. Leung Guang Sing, Vice-President of Guangzhou Islamic Association; Mr. Leung first introduced every members of the delegation. Followed by a speech from their Chairman, Imam Wang Wen Jie, and then sharing from the Chairperson of various Hong Kong Muslim organizations. The Symposium rounded up with the speeches from Mr. Wang Mao Zhu, Secretary of Department of Ethnic and Religious Affairs and Madam Shen Chong, Head of the Coordination Department of the Liaison Office of the Central People's Government.

In the afternoon, the delegation visited Huadu Art Museum after a roasted lamb feast. The delegation returned to Hong Kong by train on the third day afternoon. Although the itinerary was packed, members of the delegation had a wonderful time. Members were touched by the warmth and hospitality from the Department of Ethnic and Religious Affairs and the Guangzhou Islamic Association. The visit has truly proven that Muslims in Guangzhou and Hong Kong are one family.

# Du'a repels Allah's anger

Abu Hurairah narrated that the Prophet (saw) said:" Verily, the person who does not ask Allah, Allah gets angry at him." (Tirmidhi)

The above hadith tells us that by leaving du'a, a person in fact abandons the noblest act of worship. In addition, if he were to leave du'a out of arrogance, or a feeling of self-sufficiency, this would, in reality, be a type of disbelief in Allah, and a deification of one's self.

Concerning this hadith, one of the poets versified:" Allah gets angry if you stop asking Him. And the son of Adam, when he is asked, gets angry!

One of the most famous scholars of the second century, Imam Sufyan ath-Thaury, would start his du'a by praising Allah as follows:" O You whose most beloved servant is he who asks Him the most; and O You whose most hated servant is he who does not ask Him; and no one else is such, O Lord!"

This relates to the fact that Allah loves to be asked. Ubadah ibn Samit reports that the Prophet (saw) said:"There is no Muslim on the face of the earth that asks Allah for anything

except that Allah gives it to him, or averts from him a similar evil, as long as he does not ask for something evil or for breaking the ties of kinship." (Tirmidhi)

The concept of du'a proves the extreme and infinite Generosity of Allah, as every single created being asks Allah, day and night, morning and evening, for all of their needs, and Allah gives, and gives, and gives. Allah (swt) said:" Allah that is in the Heaven and Earth begs of Him (its needs); Everyday He has a matter to bring forth." (Ar-Rahman: 29)

So this once again shows the importance of du'a, as it is obligatory for a person to avoid Allah's anger, this is proof enough that making du'a is obligatory. Wallahu a'lam.

## Sharing of Eid-ul Fitr Celebration in Thailand & Myanmar

Eid-ul-Adha and Eid-ul-Fitr are the most joyful times of the year for Muslims. Imam Sulaiman Wang led a group of Muslims from Hong Kong and Yunnan to celebrate and experience Eid in Thailand and Myanmar in the Eid-ul-Fitr just passed few months ago. I was lucky enough to be a member of the group.

It was my first time keeping fast while travelling. It was also my first time being able to open fast, to have pre-dawn meals and to perform Taraweeh prayers with the Thai Muslim community. I felt the bond of Islamic brotherhood especially during the last few days of Ramadan. The street was full of Muslims who were going to have pre-dawn meal together.

The most memorable moment of the trip has to be visiting the Burmese refugees in Thailand. Some of them are orphans and Madarassah students. Some of them have lost both parents, some are the survival victims of tragedy, and some even suffer from post-traumatic pain. Whoever listens to their stories would have fat streams of tears running from their eyes. Although Hong Kong is not a Muslim country, we can enjoy freedom of religion, no one can stop us from following Islam; we are still negligent in performing our ibadah. I felt extremely ashamed when I compared us with the Muslims in other countries.

After the Eid prayer, we visited a few Thai-Burmese Muslim families. The Thai-Burmese Muslim community has a tradition which is to open their houses for three days consecutively from the day of Eid-ul-Fitr to welcome Muslims and Non-Muslims guests to eat at their place. All the hosts showed wonderful reception, food and drinks were non-stop presenting to the guests. Do not get it wrong, not only the rich opened their houses even the poor did the same. Every household provided free hospitality to their guests according to their ability. During the three days Eid celebration, we had tried many different variety of dishes but the most important was to strengthen the brotherhood in Islam, all praises to Allah for bringing us many wonderful hosts and new Muslim friends. I will never forget the selfless and sharing culture in the Thai-Burmese Muslim community.

I can not stop thinking about this trip on the way back home. Allahamdulaillah, Hong Kong Muslims are so blessed. I wish to take this opportunity to make appeal for the poor Thai-Burmese Muslims and poor Muslims all over the world. Please offer your help and prayers to those brothers and sisters who are suffering. May Allah (swt) improve their conditions. Ameen.

Nearly 70 students registered for the course which ended on 15 October 2016 with presentation of certificates to those who met the criteria for attendance.

Thousands of Muslims in Hong Kong celebrated one of the two important festivals in the Islamic Calendar, Eid- Adha of the Feast of Sacrifice with special prayers in all Mosque and Madraesa ( Quranic School) on Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New territories.

In Wanchai Masjid Ammar and O.R. Sadick Islamic Centre three sessions were held with one session specially for the Bahasa speaking Indonesian domestic helpers who took a day off for the celebration.



## Training Course For Indonesian Sisters



In conjunction with the Indonesian Muslim Organization Council of Hong Kong (POSMIH), the Da'wah Committee of the Islamic Union of Hong Kong (the Union) organized a training course for Indonesian sisters.

The course was held from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Sundays during the Holy Month of Ramadhan with the first session beginning on 12 June 2016 and the last session ended on Sunday 3 July 2016.

The objectives of the course were to train the sisters to be good da'wah workers; to train the trainers on how to impart Islamic knowledge to others; to be model Muslimahs; to have a better understanding of Islam and its image of peace and humanity; and to remove misconceptions about Islam and Muslims generally.

The course was attended by 117 participants and two speakers - Bro. Udin Kamiluddin and Bro.

Nasruddin Latief - were specially invited from Indonesia to conduct part of the course.

Some of the topics in the course included:

The Importance of Da'wah Fundamentals of Tauhid Modern Techniques of Da'wah Understanding World Religions How to be a Da'wah Worker Methods of Teaching Qur'an The Challenges of Da'wah

How to be a Model Muslimah in a Modern Society; and

Workshop/oratory practical training

The participants felt that the course increased their knowledge of Islam and made them more aware of the problems facing by the Muslim community. They suggested that more such courses be conducted in future to enable them to deepen their Islamic knowledge especially in the field of da'wah.

At the conclusion of course, Bro. Abdul Muhaemin bin Karim, a da'wah worker from the Union presented souvenirs to the participants and winners of a speech competition.

POSMIH is an umbrella organization comprised of 62 Indonesian Muslim associations in Hong Kong and is registered under the Societies Ordinance.

#### Indonesian Sisters Organise Function in Macau



On Sunday, 31 July 2016 nine Indonesian Muslim organizations in Macau jointly organized a function to mark the end of the Holy Month of Ramadhan.

The event, held at the Sam Pak Community Hall, was attended by over 500 sisters. Among those present were Ibu Iroh and Ibu Tini both of whom are Consuls at the Indonesian Consulate in Hong Kong looking after welfare. The Consulate also look after its nationals in Macau.

The main objective of the function was to bring the sisters together to foster closer cooperation among the various associations in Macau. It is hoped that through such gatherings, progress could be made towards a unified and efficient movement to improve the life of its members in the territory. At this event, the participants demonstrated their skills by performing nasheed and fashion shows which were very popular with the audience.

Before ending the event Bro. Abdul Muhaemin bin Karim a da'wah worker from the Islamic Union of Hong Kong gave a talk on Islam. Bro. Muhaemin reminded those present to follow in the footsteps of the Holy Prophet (pbuh). "To establish a harmonious life in a community or society" he said. "everyone should do his or her best to be mild-tempered, gentle, patient, compassionate and caring".

After his talk, Bro. Muhaemin said a du'a to thank Allah (SWT) for the success of the event.

Macau has over 6,000 Indonesian Muslim domestic helpers and many of them spend their holidays in parks or in the small Mosque situated next to the reservoir in Ramal Dos Mouros. Once a month on a Sunday, Bro. Muhaemin goes over to Macau to perform da'wah usually in parks, in community halls, in shelters or in the small Mosque.

Some of the organizations manages shelters for those sisters who have had their contract terminated by their employers or who have taken their employers to court for breach of contract.

There are at the moment seven such shelters in the formerly Portuguese administered territory, one of which is managed by the Indonesian Consulate while the other six is managed by Indonesian Muslim organizations. The combined capacity of the seven shelters is about 100 but more could be accommodated if necessary.

IUHK invited the Chief Imam of the Taipei Grand Mosque, Dr. Ibrahim Chao to give two public talks on 20 and 21 August 2016. The talks were very well-received with the seminar room jam-packed with audience.

The first talk was on the topic of the difference between Islam and the "Islamic State" or "IS". Dr. Chao clearly pointed out the meaning of Islam is "submission" and also implies peace. He then briefly went over the history development of the Muslim community and clarified some terms like jihad, sunni, and shi'a which are often misunderstood by the public. He also elaborated on the concepts of tolerance and peaceful coexistence in Islam and how Islamic laws take care of human rights and our daily needs. On the second half of the talk, Dr. Chao highlighted a few misunderstandings against Mulsims and made use of examples to show the development of conflicts

in the Middle East. He also criticized on the non-Islamic rules of the so-called "Islamic State" and ended his talk by making some suggestions to Muslim, encouraging them to practise Islam in their living so that the others can see the real Islam as opposed to the negative images of the "IS"

The second talk was about multi-culturalism and Muslim minority. Dr. Chao began his presentation with a series of questions, in order to guide the audience to understand that accepting ones' identity is the basis of facing or solving the problems of Muslim minority in a multicultural society. He then quoted some ayats from the Holy Ouran to ensure the audience that Muslims are indeed the best group of people. In fact, there is common ground between Islam and the Chinese Confucian teachings. Therefore, Muslims should made use of their unique position and the "Golden Mean" (no extreme) principle in Islam to live peacefully with others with an open mind to accept differences. To conclude these two talks, the key message of Dr. Chao was to remind Muslims, in face of chaos in the Muslim world or misunderstanding against Muslims in our society, not to forget the Islamic principles of peace, tolerance, and coexistence and to stay away from extreme thinking and action, be moderate and make Islam every part of our lives.

# Increasing number of people attending Iftar



Every year, the Welfare committee of the Islamic Union of Hong Kong, arranged Iftar meal (breaking fast) during the Holy month of Ramadan and this year no exception.

The Iftar meal, under the special arrangement with the Union, was provided free of charge by the operator of the Islamic Canteen and is open for everyone.

However, due to limited space in the Centre especially during the weekends, most people just took the food boxes and ate outside.

# Muslim lives threatened again in Myanmar

Muslims who fled from their homes by yesterday anti-Muslim attack in Thuyethamain village. In the incident, over two hundreds Buddhist villagers from the same village of Waw Township, Bago Region had destroyed properties of Muslims and their religious places including Mosque and cemetery following the argument between two neighbors.

Buddhist assailants who were part of yesterday anti-Muslim attack are proclaiming to create the village as "Muslim Free Zone", the situation widely seen across the country in recent years.

Besides that, there was another incident against Muslims in Myanmar .

It is reported that a Ma Ba Tha monk attacked a roadside shop, owned by a Muslim, located in the vicinity of Burma's famous Shwedagon Pagoda. The Monk claimed Muslims are not allowed to do business at any Buddhist temples.

The victim was a 25 year old man from Yangon. His money and belongings were seized. He was even beaten, kicked and punched after he had been escorted to the nearest monastery.

As a street vendor, the victim opened his shop in the pagoda's vicinity where many people turn up especially on religiously celebrated calendar days. Every citizens are constitutionally free to do business at any place but ultra-nationalist groups have been creating 'Muslim free Zone' across the country and calling the citizens to boycott Muslim businesses. Expelling Muslim shops at the vicinity of Buddhist religious locations have become very common in recent years.

Many Buddhist people condemned this Sunday incident, some even personally questioned at the township police station, by highlighting that this sort of discrimination goes against the teaching of Buddhism.

## Qur'an beauties show up ugly US election



A first US showing of rare old Qur'ans has opened at a Washington museum, highlighting a different side of Islam at a time when the religion's image in America has been scarred by a divisive presidential campaign.

More than 60 Qur'ans and Koranic texts, dating from the late seventh century, and considered works of art for their exceptionally fine calligraphy, are featured in The Art of the Qur'an, running through February 20 at the Freer and Sackler museums, home to the Smithsonian Institution's Asian art collection.

These majestic holy books were copied by hand for some of the richest and most powerful rulers of the Muslim world. Most of them - 47 of 63 - were lent to Freer and Sackler from a single source: the Museum of Turkish and Islamic Arts in Istanbul. The rest were already part of the Smithsonian collection.

The exhibition, contained in the intimate setting of a single room, tells the story of how the words and teachings of the Qur'an, traditionally passed on orally, came during the seventh century to be inscribed in fixed texts.

The exhibit touches lightly on the messages of the Qur'an."We are above all an art museum," deputy curator Simon Retting said. "So we come at it more from the angle of explaining how the Qur'an took the form of a book, and how the arts of calligraphy and illumination" - the decoration and illustration of manuscripts - "developed around the book."

Chief curator Massumeh Farhad said: "We wanted to really show the variety of manuscripts." The Qur'ans on display come from all parts of the Muslim world, from Iraq to Afghanistan and Turkey. There is one on parchment copied by a calligrapher in Iraq or Iran between the eighth and ninth century. Another imposing one, measuring two meters by one meter, and dating from 1599 in the Iranian city of Shiraz, is done in colored ink with gold-encrusted letters.

"Today, when you look at a Qur'an, it always looks the same - it's a printed copy with a green color, one basic size," Farhad said. "What is remarkable here is the incredible variety of them, the size, the scale, the scripts Especially when you think that the Koran is the same identical text copied over and over and over again. So you can't do something different. It's the same thing."The show comes before the presidential election on November 8, amid a polarizing campaign in which Republican Donald Trump often stigmatized Muslims, saying at one point that he would ban all Muslims, at least for a time.

The exhibit, in the works for six years, was originally set to open in 2014, but was delayed by construction.

"Now, it is true that the exhibit is opening just at the moment of the elections, with highly charged public rhetoric around Islam," Retting acknowledged. "But as our mission is to promote and spread understanding. It is opening at a very opportune moment to allow the American public to have a different image of Islam."The show represents "a tremendous opportunity for dialogue between cultures" and an occasion to "build bridges," he said.

#### UNESCO adopts resolution on al-Aqsa Mosque



Palestinian leaders have welcomed a decision by the United Nations cultural agency to adopt a resolution on occupied East Jerusalem that sharply criticises Israeli policies around the al-Aqsa Mosque compound, while Israel says it ignores Jewish ties to the key holy site.

A spokesman for Paris-based UNESCO said on Tuesday that the resolution, which caused Israel to suspend its cooperation with the agency, was adopted without a new vote after being approved at the committee stage last week.

The text refers throughout to the al-Aqsa mosque compound site in occupied East Jerusalem's Old City only by its Muslim names: al-Aqsa and al-Haram al-Sharif.

Al-Aqsa Mosque compound is the third-holiest site in Islam. Jews refer to the site as the Temple Mount.Palestine's deputy ambassador to UNESCO, Mounir Anastas, told reporters the resolution "reminds Israel that they are the occupying power in East Jerusalem and it asks them to stop all their violations", including archaeological excavations around religious sites.

The UNESCO resolution also condemned Israel for restricting Muslim access to the site, and for aggression by Israeli police and soldiers, while also recognising Israel as the occupying power.

The resolution was submitted by Algeria, Egypt, Lebanon, Morocco, Oman, Qatar and Sudan - and was originally passed with 24 votes in favour, six against, and 26 abstentions.

In April, UNESCO passed a resolution condemning "Israeli aggressions and illegal measures against the freedom of worship and Muslims' access to the al-Aqsa Mosque", also failing to mention the site's Jewish

name.In 2011, the Palestinians were admitted as a member state of the organisation, which led the United States to suspend its payments to UNESCO.


UNESCO chief Irina Bokova had distanced herself from Thursday's vote, saying in a statement: "Nowhere more than in Jerusalem do Jewish, Christian and Muslim heritage and traditions share space."

But Riyad al-Maliki, the Palestinian foreign minister, responded to Bokova by describing her comments as "completely unacceptable".

"The Palestinian government expects Ms Bokova to focus her efforts on implementing the will of member states and preserving Jerusalem from the Israeli systematic colonisation and assault on its Palestinian character," said Maliki.

# Israeli Rights Group urges UN to End Israeli occupation of Palestinian Territories



An Israeli human rights group urged the U.N. Security Council to take decisive action now to end Israeli occupation of Palestinian territories.

Hagai El-Ad, executive director of B'Tselem, told an informal council meeting Friday on "Illegal Israeli Settlements: Obstacles to Peace and the Two-State Solution" that Israel has controlled Palestinian lives in Gaza, the West Bank and East Jerusalem for the past 49 years "and counting."

"Israel will not cease being an oppressor simply by waking up one day and realizing the brutality of its policies," he said.

With the 50th anniversary approaching next year, El-Ad said "the rights of Palestinians must be realized, the occupation must end, the U.N. Secu-

rity Council must act, and the time is now."
El-Ad stressed that the council "has more than just power: you have a moral responsibility and a real opportunity to act with a sense of urgency before we reach the symbolic date of June 2017 and the second half of that first century begins."

Another Israeli rights group, Peace Now, was invited to speak but it was represented by its sister organization, Americans for Peace Now, which has also campaigned for an end to Israeli occupation.

When Israel and the Palestine Liberation Organization signed the Oslo peace accords 23 years ago, the settler population in the West Bank was 116,000, she said. At the end of 2015, it was almost 390,000.

"I urge you here today to finally take action in the Security Council to send a clear message to Israel that the international community stands by the two-state solution and unambiguously rejects policies that undermine it — including Israeli settlement policies," Friedman said.

## Myanmar aid curbs hit children in Rakhine

Unrest in Myanmar's northwest is taking a "terrible toll" on children, the U.N. children's agency UNICEF said and called for full humanitarian access to the Muslim-majority north of Rakhine state.

Tens of thousands of people have been cut off from food and other aid normally provided by international agencies since deadly attacks on police guard posts along the border with Bangladesh on Oct. 9.

"While some aid has been delivered in recent days, UNICEF calls for full resumption of essential services and the urgent lifting of all restrictions of movement of health and other professionals so they can safely reach children and families," UNICEF said.

# 朝覲的 精神和 意義





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"為世人而創設的最古的房子(意思是崇拜真主的房子),確是在麥加的那所吉祥的克爾白,全世界的嚮導。其中有許多明證,如伊布拉欣的站立處;凡人其中的人都得安寧。凡能旅行到克爾白的人,都有為真主而朝覲克爾白的義務。不信道的人(無損于真主),因為真主確是無求於眾世界的。"(古蘭經3:96-97)

穆聖(求主賜他平安與吉慶)說: "伊斯蘭建立在五大支柱之上:作證萬物非主唯有真主,穆罕默德是真主的使者,履行拜功,完納天課,在萊麥丹月齋戒,(有能力者)朝覲克爾白。"

朝覲被定為主命功課,據大多數學者的主張,是在伊斯蘭曆(簡稱伊曆)第九年(約西元六三零年)。

"你應當在眾人中宣告朝覲,他們就自遠道或徒步或乘瘦駝到你這裡來從而獲得許多益處....."( 古蘭經22:27-28)

對穆斯林來說,朝覲屬於最優美的善功。有人問穆聖(求主賜他平安與吉慶)說:"什麼善功是最優美的?"穆聖說:"信仰真主和他的使者。"那人問:"其次是什麼?"穆聖(求主賜他平安與吉慶)答道:"其次是為主道奮鬥(出征)。"那人又問:"再其次是什麼?"穆聖(求主賜他平安與吉慶)答道:"再其次是成功的朝覲。"

朝覲與五功中的其他四項功課不同,要付出體力,財力和時間,能體現為主道而奉獻的精神。履行朝覲功課,可得到真主豐厚的回賜。

穆聖(求主賜他平安與吉慶)說:"朝覲的費用 ·猶如為主道而施捨的費用:花費一個迪爾汗( 錢幣),得七百倍的回賜。"

此外,穆里(求主賜他平安與吉慶)說:"成功的朝覲,其回報就是天園。"他又說:"誰朝覲而沒有違犯禁令,亦沒有幹罪,由朝覲返來,猶如剛出生的嬰兒一樣純潔。"

朝覲雖屬宗教功課,但對人類社會亦具有重要 意義。真主說:"眾人啊!我確已從一男一女創 造你們,我使你們成為許多民族和部落,以便你 們互相認識。在真主看來,你們中最尊貴者,是 你們中最敬畏者。"(古蘭經49:13)

上述經文明確告誠我們,在真主的御前,人人平等,而最高貴的,是最敬畏真主的人。這種人人平等和以敬主愛人為人格發展方向的思想,可在不分膚色,種族,語言,國籍,階級,全球穆斯林虔誠為主而濟濟一堂的朝覲功課中得以充分體現。

此外,朝覲可培養穆斯林的兄弟情誼和增強彼此間的合作意識。在履行朝覲功課的過程中,穆斯林不可只顧自己,不顧他人,更不能傷害他人。 穆民皆兄弟,應該彼此關照,互相幫助,以求共同完成朝覲的功課。推而廣之,在日常生活中, 穆民大眾應在敬畏真主和行善止惡方面互助合作

朝覲的儀式包括多個環節,每個環節都有不同的象徵意義。朝覲由戒關受戒開始,受戒象徵撇開世俗,一心向主,由戒關往麥加和米那途中,要多念遵命詞,表明遵奉真主的命令來完成朝覲的功課;接下來,站駐阿拉法特,巡遊天房以及賽法和麥爾臥之間奔走,都旨在尋求真主的憐憫和喜悅;駐米那向石柱投石,意思是抵禦魔鬼的誘惑,鄙視邪惡,清除雜念;宰牲,更體現了為取真主的喜悅而犧牲的精神。

綜上所述,朝覲的精神是遵命順從的精神,無私奉獻的精神,互助友愛的精神,團結合作的精神。朝覲中所做的一切功課,都是為了真主,為了接近真主,為了追求獲得真主的喜悅。正如《古蘭經》所教誨的:"你說:'我的禮拜,我的犧牲,我的生,我的死,的確都是為真主——全世界的主。他絕無夥伴,我只奉到這個命令,我是首先順從的人。'"(《古蘭經》6:162-163)
